The 6-week program develops a professional support system for consultants of color to work with local nonprofits.



## Consultants of Color Training Cohort

The program introduces process consulting as an iterative form of humble inquiry and guidance in which the consultant works alongside the client to co-create solutions. The curriculum combines the tenets of process consulting as a vocation with the practical lessons of building a consulting business or operating as an internal consultant or strategist. The learning process is a student-centered, inquiry-based cooperative learning experience with a group of peers. At the end of the program, each

participant has the opportunity to earn the Certified Process Consultant™ credential.
